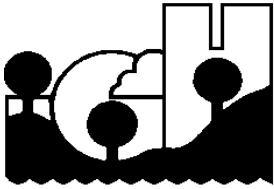
Joint presentation by Lower Mississippi River Watershed Management Organization (WMO) and Eagan-Inver Grove Heights WMO.

**Update: Survey Goes Live!**

The 2019 Community Survey is live today – April 1, 2019 - and will run (be active) through midnight on Tuesday, April 30. You can access the survey on the website ([www.invergroveheights.org](http://www.invergroveheights.org)). **Paper copies are available** at the front desk at **City Hall**, or at either the **front desk at VMCC**, or in the **VMCC Senior Center**. Paper copies must be returned to by 4:30 pm on Tuesday, April 30, 2019. (They may be brought back to any of these places.)

**Update on Responses to Comments:**

Some questions in the 2019 survey have been changed, and others added as a result of comments collected during the 2018 survey. This was done to be responsive to the feedback we heard. The results of the 2019 survey will be made public at the July 1, 2019 City Council Work Session, and in the July/August issue of Insights.

In addition, a page on the City website (under the Residents tab) has been dedicated to Survey Results and residents can sign up to be notified of changes and updates to the survey by signing up on the “Notify Me” page.

**Timing of the Survey:**

As mentioned at the January 7, 2019 Work Session, the annual survey will be held during April of each year. That will allow Staff enough time to download and organize the information from the survey and publish the results in the July issue of Insights, as well as prepare the ratings and comments at the July 1, 2019 Council Work Session.
